



OVASE Training Instructions

Part of our new volunteer onboarding process is the completion of the mandatory Office of Victim Assistance and Safe Environment (OVASE) trainings. These trainings must be completed prior to volunteering with our organization. Please follow the instructions below to complete this training.

Create a User ID and Password

Set up your account as a volunteer

Choose Catholic Charities as Primary location. If you are volunteering for Seton Home or St. PJ's specifically, choose those as your primary locations.

The system will ask you two questions. (1) Will you be working with children? And (2) Will you be working with Vulnerable Adults? The answer to **BOTH** questions should be **YES**.

Trainings must be completed prior to volunteering with our campus, whether you are a current volunteer or a prospective volunteer. Please note that these trainings are valid for three (3) years and valid at any Archdiocese affiliated location. When you log in, the classes that are required to be taken should automatically populate, you just click and take each one that shows.

If there are any trainings that are not showing up, please let us know immediately and we will have the system corrected. Due to the volume of staff and volunteers accessing the system, there may be some glitches or delays, please be patient and try again if you experience this difficulty.
